Did you know?

Traditional garbage trucks crush the rubbish collected, reducing the amount that can be diverted from landfill.

Benefits include:

- Increased diversion rates
- Improved customer experience by having clean bins on site
- Improved productivity due to single bin requirement. There is no need to have separate bins back of house for general and recycling rubbish.
- Collection techniques result in reduced compression during transport, increasing items that are eligible for recycling.



We separate into Waste Streams:

- Container Deposit Scheme (CDS)
- Coffee & disposable paper cups
- Liquids
- Co-mingled Recycling
- Landfill
- Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO)

Whilst coffee cups are not recyclable, we have a recycling partner that processes and shreds the cups, which is combined with other plastic materials to make it suitable to upcycle into new products such as lightweight concrete slabs, garden beds and car stops. These new products are all made locally in Australia.

Our operations work closely with our waste partners to transport your recycling to a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) for processing. With shared goals for sustainable waste management outcomes, our partners guarantee separate collection of single-streamed recycling and landfill as well as the proper disposal of each waste stream.

Did you know?

Where there might be contamination to the contents in a recycling bin, current waste collection providers will dispose of the entire contents of the bin directly to landfill.




Verification/Validation & Reporting:

Verification/Validation & Reporting: Olinga Services will systematically collect and analyse relevant data at every stage of the process. Our proprietary electronic reporting systems allow for data capture at multiple points and enable our operations team to provide real-time reporting to our clients.

Reporting includes:

- Weighing gross weight on pick up
- Post sorting, weight and photos of each waste stream
- Third Party reports from our partners
- Monthly and annual Corporate Emissions Reduction
- Corporate Emissions Reduction Transparency (CERT) report
- National Australian Built Environment Rating System (NABERS) reporting
